- Registered Band Members of Glooscap First Nation are eligible to be nominated for any of these awards. The Community Award is a little different - anyone who is recognized as a part of our community, regardless of their status or ethnicity, can be nominated.

AWARD CATEGORIES	
Leadership	Acknowledges a Band Member who has had a significant positive impact on others through their leadership. This person is a positive role model and mentor, and supports people holistically in their personal, professional, and/or academic pursuits.
Business	Acknowledges a Band Member who is a business owner, or works for a Glooscap-owned business. This person displays passion, creativity, and empowerment through their work. Their business reflects GFN values and creates social, cultural, or environmental benefits for the community.
Nature	Acknowledges a Band Member who displays a strong connection to, and respect for nature. This person honours our traditional lands and resources, advocates for environmental protection, and helps others create their own connection with nature.
Family	Acknowledges a family of Glooscap First Nation. This family can be immediate, extended, or nuclear (not-related). The nominated family shows values like love, respect, and trust - not only to each other, but to all people in their lives. They are strengthened by each other to persevere and overcome challenges, and work together to support people and families in their community.
Student	Acknowledges a student Band Member who is passionate about their education and studies. This person may have reached an academic achievement, demonstrated leadership skills, or engaged with their community and peers to share their knowledge and skills.
Culture	Acknowledges a Band Member who takes pride in learning, practicing, and sharing Mi'kmaq culture. This person honors our culture through their lifestyle, sharing traditional teachings, and using their knowledge to enhance the lives of others.
Volunteer	Acknowledges a Band Member who has made significant contributions as a volunteer across a range of programs, events and/or causes. This person will be recognized 'Volunteer of the Year' on behalf of GFN at the NS Provincial Volunteer Awards, held in April 2021.
Community (This person does NOT need to be a registered Band Member).	Acknowledges a Band Member, staff, resident, family, or group who make a significant contribution to our sense of Community. This person brings good vibes to community spaces and events, and helps maintain communication and connection throughout the year.
